Improved access for Strathpine pedestrians

Pedestrian access and safety in Strathpine will be boosted thanks to two new pedestrian crossings at the Gympie and South Pine roads intersection.

Transport and Main Roads Director-General Neil Scales said the improvements would provide better pedestrian access for people crossing near the Strathpine Library and local shops.

"The works will involve installing two new pedestrian crossings, new line marking and sign improvements to highlight pedestrians may be crossing on the slip lanes," Mr Scales said.

"Works will be undertaken between 8pm and 5am due to the volumes of traffic using the intersection and to minimise disruption to motorists.

"Some delays through the work zone can be expected.

"Traffic controllers and reduced speed limits will be in place.

"We thank everyone for their patience and remind motorists to allow for the changed conditions to ensure safety through the worksite."

The improvements are scheduled to start this month (late November).
