Maximum penalty—20 penalty units.

Example for paragraph (a)—

driving a vehicle in a way that causes noise or smoke because of—

- (a) disrepair of the vehicle; or
- (b) the way the vehicle is loaded; or
- (c) the condition, construction or adjustment of the vehicle's engine or other equipment

Example for paragraph (b)—

driving a vehicle in a way that causes noise or smoke by wilfully and unnecessarily causing the wheels of the vehicle to lose traction and spin on the road surface

Note—

An offence against paragraph (b) is an offence mentioned in the *Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000*, section 69A(1)(a)(iv).

- (2) A person must not drive a vehicle to which a noisy instrument is attached or on which a noisy instrument is used.

Maximum penalty—20 penalty units.

- (3) The driver of a vehicle or a passenger in or on the vehicle must not—

- (a) ring a bell or sound a horn, except a horn or similar warning device under [section 224](#); or
- (b) play or use a noisy instrument.

Maximum penalty—20 penalty units.

Response (Please attribute to a Transport and Main Roads spokesperson):

We have been encouraging Queenslanders to report smoky vehicles for several years because smoky exhausts contribute to air pollution and can distract drivers.

In the 2018-19 financial year, we received 3169 reports of vehicles emitting excessive smoke. There were 2203 reports in the 2017-18 financial year and 1806 vehicles reported in the 2016-17 financial year. We do not record vehicle types, including make and model.

Anyone who sees a vehicle blowing smoke continuously for 10 seconds or more, can report the vehicle by submitting a [smoky vehicle report form](#) via the Transport and Main Roads website.

Once a vehicle is identified, a letter is sent to the owner explaining the vehicle was reported, along with suggestions on fixing the problem.

If the vehicle is reported three times within four months of the first sighting, the owner is issued with a Present Vehicle Order (PVO) for the vehicle to be checked for defects by a TMR Transport Inspector.

Background

There are simple steps you can take to make sure your vehicle's emission levels are as low as possible.
