fadd body of email here\}TMR have conducted an investigation and have confirmed with our maintenance contractor that a spill occurred on this intersection on Wednesciay 15 September 2021 after a truck rollover incident. This spill was cleaned the same day, in line with the Routine Maintenance Guidelines set out by TMR.

To ensure that the hazard had been completely cleared, the maintenance crew attended the location again on Thursday 16 and Friday 17 September 2021 and found no residual spill.

As the incident that resulted in damage to your vehicle occurred on Sunday 19 September 2021, there is insufficient information to suggest that this spill contributed to road conditions on that day.
